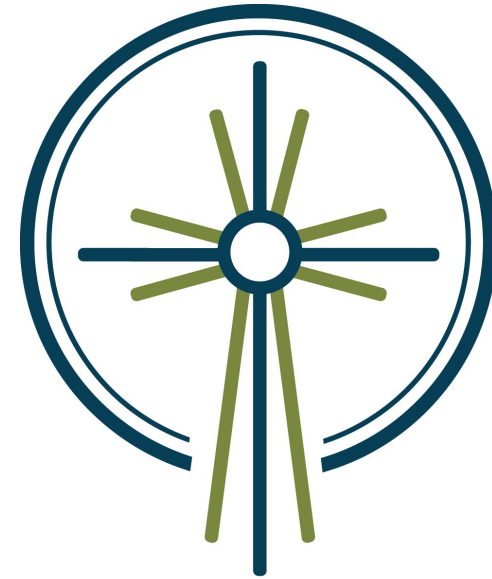

Prayer of Confession

Please consider the following prayer of confession in the quiet of your mind and heart.

Father, your commandment calls upon us to maintain and promote truth between ourselves and others in all manner of circumstances. It exhorts us to do all that we can to speak well of our neighbors, guarding their reputations at every opportunity. It bids us to do this particularly in those matters which affect our neighbors legally or financially. We confess that we have not always acted with complete honesty toward others. We have been disingenuous, deceitful, disrespectful, and denigrating toward others with our words and our witness, both in speaking to them and in speaking about them to others. Forgive us. By your Spirit, give us the wisdom to understand what it means to speak the truth in love, whether with our mouths or with our fingers on a keyboard. Give us the grace of Christ that we might speak to and about others in a similar manner to that by which he has spoken to us and about us before your throne. Show us those from whom we need to seek forgiveness for the sinful manner in which we have spoken to or about them. Compel us to pursue reconciliation with them to the glory of your name. We pray this in Jesus Christ, Amen.
