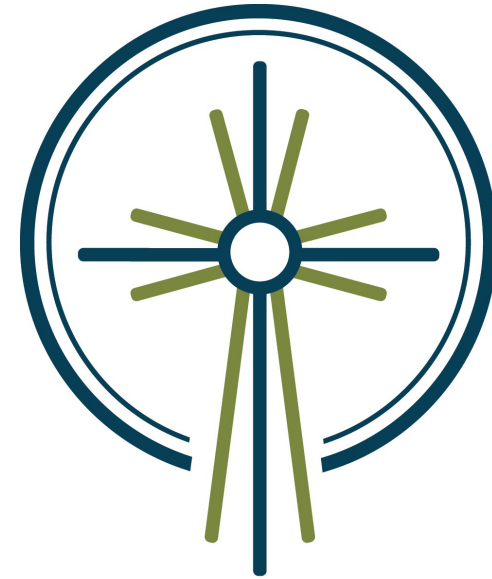

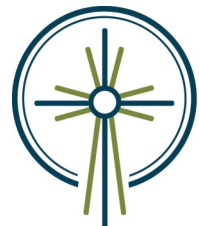

Call to Confession • Titus 2:2-8

Older men are to be sober-minded, dignified, self-controlled, sound in faith, in love, and in steadfastness. Older women likewise are to be reverent in behavior, not slanderers or slaves to much wine. They are to teach what is good, and so train the young women to love their husbands and children, to be self-controlled, pure, working at home, kind, and submissive to their own husbands, that the word of God may not be reviled. Likewise, urge the younger men to be self-controlled. Show yourself in all respects to be a model of good works, and in your teaching show integrity, dignity, and sound speech that cannot be condemned, so that an opponent may be put to shame, having nothing evil to say about us.

Heavenly Father, we know that the sinful passions of our old self war against the intentions of our new self in Christ. Show us those ways in which our passions distort the truth and beauty of your good blessings to us. Show us those ways in which the world encourages us to pursue our passions with reckless abandon and without shame. In seeing our uncontrolled sinfulness may we come to repentance in Christ, seeking to turn from those ungodly ways into the self-controlled enjoyment of all that you have given to us. May we exercise a Christlike, humble appreciation for beauty, material things, other people created in your image, and so on. Increase within us the fruit of self-control to your glory! In Jesus' name, amen.
